LATISSE by Allergan

LATISSE is a treatment for hypotrichosis (having inadequate or not enough eyelashes). This once daily prescription medication will enhance the length, thickness, and darkness of eyelashes in as little as eight weeks, with full results at sixteen weeks.

Safety Information

Apply LATISSE once daily at night to the skin of the upper eyelid margins at the base of the eyelashes using the FDA approved applicator. Use one applicator per eye. **DO NOT APPLY** to the lower eyelid.

LATISSE may cause:

- ⇒ Darkening of the eyelid skin, which may or may not be reversible
- \Rightarrow Increased brown pigmentation of the iris (colored part of the eye), which can be more permanent
- ⇒ Hair growth in other areas of your skin that LATISSE touches

Common side effects:

- \Rightarrow Eye redness (3.6%)
- \Rightarrow Itchy eyes (3.6%)
- ⇒ Skin Hyper pigmentation (2.9%)
- ⇒ Iris Color Changes / Darkening (?%) Dependent on amount that gets in the eye

Treatment Plan - Schedule visits not covered by medical/vision insurance

- ⇒ Initial office visit to discuss goals, obtain baseline measurements, and instruct on usage and side effect. \$79.00
- \Rightarrow Second and third office visit at 4 weeks and 8 weeks to observe results and discuss any questions or concerns. \$55.00
- ⇒ Third and Fourth office visit at 12 weeks and 16 weeks to confirm results, discuss effects and answer any questions or concerns. \$55.00
- ⇒ Routine annual examination thereafter.
